

Notice to Proprietors of Public Places
City of Brantford Clean Air By-law
Designated Smoking Areas

(revised May 28, 2002)

As of June 1, 2002 all public places in Brantford must be smoke-free. However, the By-law does provide for the establishment of Designated Smoking Areas (DSAs).

In order to establish a DSA, the following approvals process must be followed:

For All Renovation Requiring a Building Permit:

- ✓ The applicant must receive approval by following the normal City of Brantford requirements for new construction. Contact the Building Department at 759-4150 for details.
- ✓ Prior to operation of the DSA, the applicant must provide documentation from a Professional Engineer confirming that the DSA meets the technical specifications as set out in the By-law.

For Proposals Not Requiring Building Department Approval:

- ✓ The applicant must submit a plan of the proposed DSA to the Brant County Health Unit. This plan must include the size and location of the DSA.
- ✓ Prior to operation of the of the DSA, the applicant must provide documentation from a Professional Engineer confirming that the DSA meets the technical specifications as set out in the By-law.
